Pune Institute of Computer Technology would like to cordially invite you for the meeting of Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC).

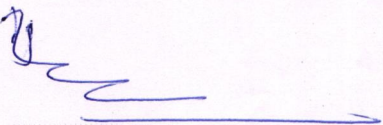

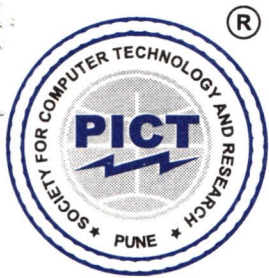
Your expertise and knowledge in the area would add a great value for smooth functioning of IQAC.

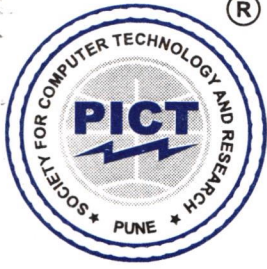

1. Dr. A. S. Ghotkar, IQAC Coordinator briefed about status of action plan of previous IQAC meeting. She also presented action plan for the year 2018-19.

2. **Quality education parameter:** Dr. P. T. 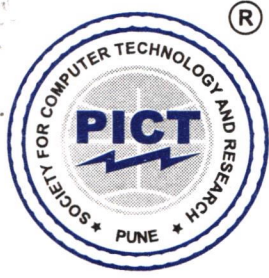
8/10/2018 **Resolution: It is decided to conduct certificate courses and tests for skill up gradation by respective department to enhance one of the quality education parameter**

Proposal on Machine Learning and AI course is prepared and sent to AICTE for necessary permission
5	It is decided to increase the internship opportunities to the students	Internships are encouraged with the permission of HoD and Principal, Identified potential industries who offer internship to the PICT students. MOU is done with various reputed companies like e-Zest, software solution, Indeed software solution, NTTDATA, 3DPLM Microsoft, Goldman Sach, UBS, Siemens, Schulmbergear, Barcalyas, Dell, and RedHat Academy etc. for providing internships. Internship through INTERNSHALA is also initiated. Almost 208 students completed internship in above mentioned companies, and more than 10 students got PPO. Under PICT Research internship, more than 65 students are doing internships in various area like Wireless Communication, ML, IoT, BlockChain.
